* **SATURDAY 1st** - The "Underground Daze" tale picks up again on the Magic Moments Facebook page (URL at bottom), frames 55-57 covering the end of 1994 and how we came to get such a brilliant artist as 2000 AD's Thayen Rich to do our album.

Thursday 1st October 1987 - Work began on the mastering and packaging of the 'W21' releases; "The MMATT Story" (C-4011), "Live At Frimley Community Centre" (C-4012), "At Twilight Time" by Magic Moments (C-4013) and "Magic Moments" by At Twilight Time. They were eventually released on November 7th.

* **SUNDAY 2nd -** "Underground Daze" frames 58-59; the return of Lulu The Space Bimbo, but sad news for the Magic family.

Tuesday 6th October 1987 - Received a letter of thanks from Greenpeace for the contribution we had made from the proceeds of The Grain Festival we'd performed at and helped organise.

* **FRIDAY 7th** - "Underground Daze" frames 60-63; waxing lyrical about the visit of Sons Of Selina, in the stiflingly hot summer of 1995, to The White Hart in Frimley, where we had played only our second gig, some eight years earlier.

* **SATURDAY 8th** - "Underground Daze" frames 64-65; much confusion and hilarity about our foreign visitors, getting absolutely hammered on ouzo with Flowers Of Romance front man, Mike Pougounas, on Shepherds Bush Green, then bumping into the man I had originally thought was phoning me, Mana Erg's Bruno De Angelis, doing the final mixdown of "Creavolution" at Marc Bell's Brain Dead Studios in London.

* **SUNDAY 9th -** "Underground Daze" frames 66-69; with the album finished, the launch poster appears, advance promo cassettes are circulating and there's that fabulous artwork from Thayen Rich. Not to mention a wicked spoof by Cheapo Card Company's Wil Walker. Yes, seriously, don't mention that...

Saturday 12th October 1974 - The Wombles' "Minuetto Allegretto" enters the charts! I was still living with them on Wimbledon Common at the time, that was some party!

* **FRIDAY 14th** - "Underground Daze" frames 70-72; the arrival of the infamously awful F.A.M.E. 'coffee table' pressing of "Creavolution" and the beginning of the year of hell, with the lengthy and bitter legal case that ensued and the death of my father.

* **SATURDAY 15th** - "Underground Daze" frames 73-75; Sounds Good of Theale in Berkshire come to the rescue, along with much moral support from the wider underground community and beyond. Finally, "Creavolution" (MMATT CD 1) gets its release and boxes of *decent* pressings get to clutter up our living room!

* "CREAVOLUTION" ON REVERBNATION - To celebrate, we'll be putting a specially edited version of the album online for your aural pleasuring. Enjoy muchly!

Thursday 15th October 1987 - Mastered the At Twilight Time album.

* **SUNDAY 16th** - "Underground Daze" frames 76-79; the legal battle continues for over a year, but we ultimately emerge victorious and "Creavolution" goes on to be our best selling album ever, outselling all our earlier cassette albums put together!

* **FRIDAY 21st** - "Underground Daze" frames 80-81; my tribute to the band's latter generation members - Leonie "Lulu" Jackson and the inimitable Pete Program.

* **SATURDAY 22nd** - "Underground Daze" frames 82-83; my tribute to the band's original line up of Shona Moments, Kate Twilight and Jay Time.

Thursday 22nd October 1987 - Received a sample copy of the "Tapeworm Vol. 1" compilation (Earworm Records, OHR 031), which featured the two tracks recorded at our studio debut. * SUNDAY 23rd - "Underground Daze" frames 84-85; As part of the build up to the main event, I get to say thank you to everybody that has ever been a part of the Magic Moments At Twilight Time adventure and we bring the story up to the present day. * DOWN THE RABBIT HOLE: See full details on the following page!

*TUESDAY 25th - HAPPY 30th ANNIVERSARY, MAGIC MOMENTS!

Saturday 25th October 1986 - The first ever MMATT recordings, from what became known as 'The W20 Sessions', following the intervention of a certain small three-eyed green alien.

Wednesday 28th October 1987 - Wimbledon knock Newcastle United out of the FA Cup on their way to the famous victory at Wembley Stadium on 14th May 1988. Go Wombles!

Monday 30th October 1989 - Ken MacKenzie's Rat Music Company becomes the first underground mailorder distro to stock MMATT cassettes. We're still friends to this day.

STARDATE: SUNDAY 23rd OCTOBER 2016

*All times shown are in UK local BST (British Summer Time) with UTC (Coordinated Universal Time) in brackets. If you're on the far side of the USA from us (Pacific Daylight Time), your conversion is BST -8, and do please accept our apologies for making you get out of bed at 6:30 on a Sunday morning, at least grab a coffee, okay? On the Atlantic side of the USA (Eastern Daylight Time) it's BST -5, so you're a bit luckier, you get to have breakfast first. Toast and all. For Germany, France etc (Central European Summer Time) it's BST +1, you'll have even had time to let your dinner go down. We spoil you, huh? Shona Moments was from Wellington, New Zealand, so we're not going to forget you down there. But at BST +12, it'll be early hours of Monday morning. Sorry!

14:30 (13:30): THE SPEECH

14:45 (13:45): DEPARTURE 15:20 (14:20): ARRIVAL

15:27 (14:27): THE TV INTERVIEW 15:28 (14:27): THE PARADE

15:29 (14:29): THE RECEPTION 15:29 (14:29): THE CONCERT

> I will be posting a few words on the MMATT Facebook page, before handing over to our Sam (who will re-post everything to my Facebook account) on this side, and The Doc and Mick Tron on the other (see 'Connections' at the back for full details of all the links).

- > I will be leaving the house in Knott End to make my way to the pick up point, which has to remain secret, for obvious reasons.
 > About this time, due to the somewhat trippy nature of interdimensional travel (see The Doc's page, right after this one, 'Note 1 Timey Wimey Stuff', for all the details and explanations), you should be seeing the first photos of my arrival on the alternate Earth. Possibly for the second time, if they were already posted in 'real time' when I arrived there on Thursday 20th, three days before I left here (The Doc's page again, 'Note 2 Real Time Vs Transdimensional Tether Time').
- > You should now be seeing stills from my appearance on their Monday Night ('Note 2' again) TV programme, "The 20-20 Show". The Doc and Mick Tron will also be on with me, talking about the following day's celebrations.
- > Coming at you thick and fast in TT Time (still on 'Note 2'), you will now be seeing photographs from the events of 25th October itself, starting with the tickertape parade along Blackpool Promenade. The Doc, Mick Tron and myself, will be atop an open-topped bus, re-designed to look like a giant Ford Escortron. We will, of course, be waving to the gathered crowds as we go, throwing sticks of rock to the children and chips and gravy to the adults.
- > It will now be 4 pm on the Tuesday where we are, at which time we are to have a champagne reception at The Rock & Roll Hall Of Fame. Again, we will be posting photos of the event. And to think, we were just planning half a lager and a bag of crisps in the pub here.
 > While it will now be 8 pm for us, barely a minute will have passed for you (you guessed, 'Note 2'), and we will now begin posting photos from the MMATT 30 Tribute Concert, where some of the biggest bands on their Earth will be performing covers of our songs (I *think* The Doc was joking about REM playing "Squashed Elephant", but do you *really* want to take a chance on missing that?), culminating in the three of us joining The Sound Machine on stage to perform an encore of "State Of The Art".
- > Having now spent six days over there from my point of view (kind of 'Notes' 1 AND 2 really), Blackpool Promenade will be closed off for my official departure. The Doc will be posting photos of my farewells (buy tissues), boarding the Ford Escortron, take off etc.
 > Allowing for transdimensional drift ('Note 1'), I should land back here circa 15:35 BST and expect to be online in the Mmattland office by 4 pm, ready to spend 2-3 hours answering questions, as well as streaming videos of the TV interview, highlights of the parade and champagne reception, the entire tribute concert and my ceremonial send-off in the Ford Escortron on Blackpool Promenade.





Greetings Earthlets!

Now, you may well be familiar with quantum mechanics, with all of its quark particles, strangeness and charm, yes? Well, transdimensional science is, I'm afraid, also a tad on the complicated side. Your Mick Magic, jolly nice young chap that he is, has asked me to write a few words for this anniversary programme, to explain some of the weird temporal effects that occur when hopping from one reality to another. We have been working on a piece of technology called the Gamma Syndrome Corporation Transdimensional TetherTM, a remarkable device which will enable Mick to spend nearly two weeks in our reality, whilst only being away from yours for some 20 minutes, thus ensuring the housework, washing and ironing do not get neglected. The first bizarre effect of this is that he will arrive here circa 8:30 on the morning of Thursday 20th October, three days before he leaves your side! He will, therefore, be able to post messages from here to his past self on your Earth! Confused? Yes, well,

NOTE 1 "TIMEY WIMEY STUFF"

The Transdimensional Tether consists of two devices that form a link, or connection, via interdimensional space, from our reality to yours, and vice versa. Our pilot will deploy the first before he crosses the threshold from our side, forming a link which will allow him to return to the same point in time he left (hence how Mick arrives at a time before he leaves), less 'drift' (*as spacetime is constantly expanding, the chronal link will have moved forward by an average of 1/840th of actual passed time). It's extremely useful as it allows you to travel across several dimensions, stay for a fortnight, and still be home before your pizza is ready. But I digress, which is most unlike me. Our pilot will then deploy the second as he crosses the exit threshold into your reality, thus completing the com-link that makes this event possible. Indeed, without this innovation, you would have needed to be sat in front of your monitor for 12 days and 18 hours to follow it from start to finish. And, of course, Mick would have had to be away from home for much longer than Sam would have let him out for.

NOTE 2 "REAL TIME (RT) VS. TRANSDIMENSIONAL TETHER TIME (TTT) " The calendars of our worlds run in perfect synchronisation, hence the date and time will match, the only relevant difference being that we have no kind of 'daylight saving time', so Mick will need to put his watch back one hour before he sets off. Oh, and perhaps it is worth mentioning that on our Earth. October is the 8th month of the year, not the 10th, and we call it Octobris. Nevertheless, the important point is that our Octobris 25th will be your October 25th too, that is *Real Time*. Now, TTT, on the other hand, runs relative to the devices deployed by our pilot. For the sake of this event, we will communicate with you via the tether, so you will receive everything in relation to the drift on the chronal lock on your side. At approximately 1/840th of RT, it effectively means that 24 hours here will appear to you as about 1.7 minutes, whilst still passing, from our point of view, at normal speed. In other words, when Mick first arrives, you will be receiving information from our past, then once we have crossed the synch point (when Mick enters interdimensional space on October 23rd), you will begin to get information from our future. Um... if anyone would like to put a bet on for me, I'll happily make it worth your while. I digress again, forgive me. So, prior to the synch point, Mick may well send the odd message from here in RT. Beyond it, we will stick to TTT to avoid the confusion of your receiving the same information twice, up to three days apart. Simples...

I have, in nice little boxes, placed two explanatory notes about how this will affect your perception of the event. If you still don't quite understand and have further questions you would like to ask, one can only assume the banana is beginning to win the battle. Enjoy muchly!

As far as we have come with transdimensional technology to this point in time, Facebook will necessarily be the main platform for all of our communication during my trip to the other side. From this Earth, I will have the helm until 14:45 BST, when I need to leave for the pick up point. After this, Sensemillia Peach (Sam for short) will be taking over. From the other Earth, Dr. Albert M. Tron and Mick Tron will be in charge of things, all posting directly to the MMATT Facebook page, which will serve as the main hub. Back on our Earth, Sam will repost anything relevant that should turn up on my account to that page also .

Those of you without Facebook accounts will still be able to see events unfold on the MMATT page, but you may have to put up with an occasional pop-up trying to persuade you to sell your soul, and you obviously won't be able to interact on the medium in the same way. You will, of course, be able to e-mail us. Sam will be checking the inbox regularly and responding as necessary, so you are still very welcome to get involved. Having said that, it might well be worth your while setting up a temporary account, if just to get the best from the day itself. The only information Facebook requires for this is a name (and you can make one up if you prefer, but do slip us the wink beforehand, won't you), gender and a date of birth (neither of which have to be yours) and a valid e-mail address (and you'll be pleased to hear I've never been spammed on the one I use for Facebook, and they do leave you alone when you close the account afterwards; I tried this with a dummy account several months ago without problems). Worth a thought, huh?

If, for any reason, you are unable to be with us on October 23rd (and it had better be a good one, don't think we won't check!), all the lowdown will appear in The Magic Net Newszine (on the website), a couple of days later on the band's actual 30th anniversary. The Rise 2016 (July - October) issue is currently online, complete with all the latest news on MMATT, the M&E label and all things underground, enjoy muchly!
